JUMP START TO COLLEGE

Hall County Schools provides a number of programs to help students increase college readiness and the likelihood of college success. In addition to Advanced Placement courses on the high school campus, the <u>Accel Program</u> allows students to be jointly enrolled in high school and at a local college such as Gainesville State College, Brenau University, and North Georgia College and State University. <u>Dual Enrollment</u> also allows students to attend college while enrolled in high school. Lanier Technical College provides dual enrollment certificate programs at Hall County's Lanier Career Academy, as well as on the Technical College campus. Many of these courses may be transferred to other diploma and degree programs at the college. Additionally, various high school career and technical classes have been <u>articulated</u> with Georgia's technical colleges. To learn more about these and other exciting opportunities, read on!



ACCEL PROGRAM

The purpose of the Accel Program is to provide Georgia high school students with the opportunity to earn college degree-level credit hours as they simultaneously meet their high school graduation requirements. To be eligible for this program, a student must be classified as a high school junior or senior. Accel students must also be admitted and classified as dual-credit students enrolled in college degree-level coursework.

Accel courses are available only in the areas of the core graduation requirements for college preparatory students: English, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, and Modern Language. College courses under this program must come from the approved course directory posted on the Georgia Student Finance Commission website at www.gsfc.org. Previously approved Accel college courses and their high school equivalents are noted in the Accel Quick Reference.
